Selin Atalay is Professor of Marketing at Frankfurt School of Finance & Management since September 2014. Before joining the Frankfurt School of Finance & Management, she has been an Associate Professor of Marketing at HEC Paris and Assistant Professor at Bilkent University. Selin Atalay holds a Ph.D. in Marketing from Penn State University. Her research interests focus primarily on consumer decision-making processes. She is mostly interested in the effects of affect on consumer decision making as well as visual attention, retail shelf location, self-gifting behavior, social exclusion.

Katharina Hombach is Assistant Professor of Accounting. After graduating from Frankfurt School (Bachelor of Science, Business Administration), Katharina went on to study Law and Accounting at the London School of Economics (Master of Science) and wrote her dissertation at WHU – Otto Beisheim School of Management. Her research is about the economic consequences of firms' public disclosure and the role of disclosure regulation.

Kim Remans obtained her PhD in Bioscience Engineering from the Free University of Brussels. After that, she worked for 5 years as a postdoc at the Max Planck Institute of Molecular Physiology in Dortmund in the group of Prof. Dr. Alfred Wittinghofer. The focus of her postdoctoral research was the expression, purification and characterization of ciliary proteins. She joined EMBL in 2015 as head of the protein expression and purification core facility.
